Financial...

- After tour application has been approved, a \$250 deposit is required. The deposit goes toward the applicant's tour fund. Along with the signing of the Crossover Tour Application Contract, this serves to secure his/her roster spot. A deposit without a signed contract or vice versa will void any agreement. A deposit, signed contract, and a credit card must be given to Crossover before a roster spot is reserved.
- During the process of fundraising, applicants must adhere to the financial date deadlines, detailed here: Tour members are expected to have...
 - o A minimum of 1/3 of their funds raised and turned in 60 days before the start of training camp.
 - o A minimum of 2/3 of their funds raised and turned 30 days before the start of training camp.
 - o A 100% of their funds raised are required 15 days before the start of training camp. If funds have not been received by each due date, the credit card on file will be charged the remaining amount due.
- Failure to follow these deadlines will result in the tour member's contract being voided. Funds will be regarded as a donation and will not be reimbursed to the tour member or donors under any circumstance. These include, but are not limited to:
 - o Any amount of money exceeding the required minimum. The funds will be kept as a donation to the ministry.
 - o Tour members who have signed the Crossover Application Tour Contract and back out of his/her contract at any time between the original signing and the beginning of the tour will not receive a refund of any amount.
 - If extenuating circumstances are responsible for this delay, Crossover will, at their discretion, roll the funds over to the next year's tour. This will be done only once.
 - o Donors who have supported tour members who have signed the Crossover Application Tour Contract and, for any reason, back out of his/her contract at any time between the original signing and the beginning of the tour will not receive a refund of any amount.
- The money that has been raised for player support will be used for the planning and institution of tours, both domestic and international.

Guidelines & Expectations...

- Tour members are expected to have a Christian Commitment and a heart to serve Jesus Christ and to encourage others to do the same. In other words, all Crossover International tour members must be in full support of using the game of basketball to impact the lives of others positively by sharing the Gospel and are expected to fully participate in all related activities.
- Tour members are expected to follow the given schedule and to be flexible to any changes made by the tour directors.
- Tour members are to refrain from the use of any profanity, drugs, or alcohol for the entirety of the tour.
- Tour members are expected to be prompt and participate in all the Crossover activities and events during training camp and tour.
- Tour members should maintain good attitudes and sportsmanship for the duration of the tour.
- Tour members should challenge themselves to indulge in self-improvement physically, mentally, and spiritually over the duration of the tour.
- Applicants and tour members are to understand that violation of any of these terms and conditions may result in early termination from participating in the tour at any point.

The purpose of these guidelines is to ensure that Crossover International has the most beneficial and fulfilling trips possible. As we all seek and serve God through His ministry, our goal should be to set an example for one another and for those that we come in contact with during our travels.
